Sustainable asphalt products

Roadways produces a range of asphalt mixes containing recycled glass and rubber.

These fully-compliant products divert Tasmanian waste from landfill and reduce the demand for raw materials, creating a more sustainable construction and maintenance lifecycle for the industry.



Glassphalt

Our high-performing recycled glass products have been in use on Tasmanian roads for more than a decade. We source our glass from Tasmanian recycling plants and use glass fragments that would otherwise go to landfill, actively contributing to the solution for waste management in the state.

We produce a range of Glassphalt base and wearing course mixes. Our wearing course mixes are compliant with the DSG and VicRoads Standard Specifications. Our 5% Glassphalt wearing course mix is a warm mix, using less energy and emitting fewer emissions than standard hot mixes.

Crumb rubber

Road surfaces containing recycled rubber significantly reduce road noise and extend the life of roads by making them more durable and sustainable.

Our new DSG-compliant crumb rubber asphalt mix uses a binder containing rubber from recycled tyres from the freight industry. The binder can be blended to suit site conditions and incorporated directly to the asphalt mix during production operations, producing a high-quality outcome.

Each ton of Glassphalt contains the equivalent of 375 glass bottles.
